The Job in Jeopardy assistance program

The Job in Jeopardy assistance program is a free service available to any worker who is at risk of losing their job due to injury, illness or disability. It is a personalised service, delivered by experienced employment consultants, which will look at what can be done to keep you in your current job.

JOB IN JEOPARDY ASSISTANCE CAN INCLUDE:

- Personalised support for 6 months
- A workplace assessment to identify any workstation, duties or equipment changes that would make it easier for you to work
- Funded specialised equipment through IPAR and the Disability Employment Services Scheme
- Assistance with retraining if needed
- Access to occupational therapy services to ensure any changes are sustainable for the future

ELIGIBILITY FOR JOB IN JEOPARDY ASSISTANCE

To be eligible for Job in Jeopardy Assistance, you must be an Australian resident, aged 14 - 65 years, and have been employed for at least eight hours a week on average over the last 13 weeks.

You will have a health or medical condition, physical or psychological, which impacts your ability to do your job and places you at risk of losing your job.

ACCESSING JOB IN JEOPARDY ASSISTANCE

Job in Jeopardy assistance is available through direct registration with Disability Employment Services provider, IPAR. You do not need a referral to access this service.
